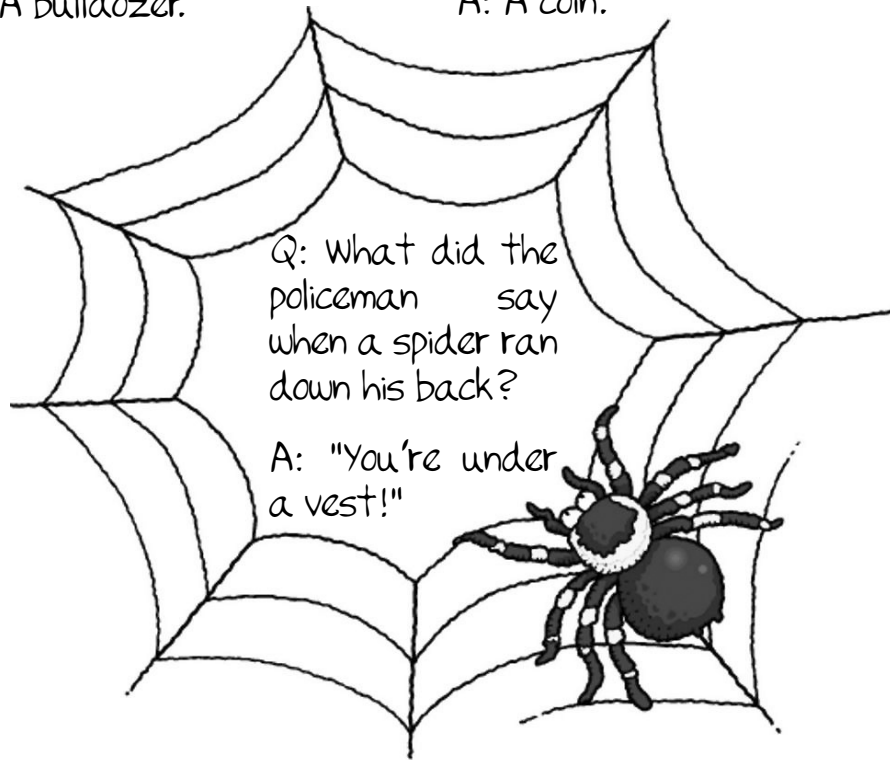
Q: What has cities without houses, rivers, without water, and forests without trees?
